<p><b>19-22 /08</b></p>	<p><b>FESTIVAL OF FOLK ARTS</b>  The Festival of Folk Arts is organised in the castle district of Budapest. Traditional Hungarian craftsmen show their talents and sell their hand made products. A lively event with lots of folk music and dance.</p> <p>St. Stephan Day -20<sup>th</sup> of August.-National Holiday- ending with great firework over the River Danube</p>	
<p><b>20<sup>th</sup> AUGUST</b></p>	<p><b>RED BULL AIR RACE IN BUDAPEST</b>  During this international series of air races, pilots fly individually against the clock and have to complete tight turns through a slalom course consisting of pylons, known as "Air Gates". The races are accompanied by program of show flights.</p>

8-12/09	<p><b>19<sup>th</sup> International Wine and Champagne Festival – Budapest Castle</b> The Wine Festival had grown into the most highly regarded and popular professional event and combined arts festival of Central Europe, where each year many tens of thousands learn the art of sophisticated wine consumption and get to know the wine makers and the traditions associated with viticulture. The main event of the internationally renowned festival will be held in what is maybe Budapest's most atmospheric setting, the Buda Castle District, listed as a world heritage site by UNESCO.</p>
